INDEPENDENT EXAMINERS REPORT TO THE TRUSTEES OF LONDON BUDDHIST VIHARA TRUST (LBV TRUST)

I report to the trustees on my examination of the accounts for the year ended 30 November 2021.

Responsibilities and basis of report:

Having satisfied myself that the accounts of the LBV are not required to be audited and are eligible for independent examination, I report in respect of my examination of your charity's accounts as carried out under section 145 of the Charities Act 2011 ('the 2011 Act'). Independent examiner's statement:

I have completed my examination. I confirm that no matters have come to my attention in connection with the examination giving me cause to boliove that:
